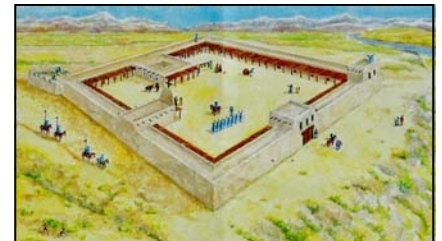
SPANISH SOLDIERS

Hike to the ruins of the Presidio Santa Cruz de Terrenate

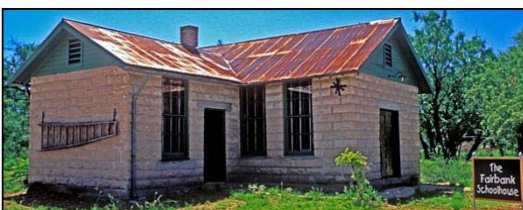
5 miles, rated moderate,
